Co-Chairman Rodney Weaver called the meeting to order at 7:00PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Minutes:** The minutes were emailed to the Board of Supervisors. Justin Snook motioned to approve the April 7, 2026 business meeting minutes as presented. Rodney Weaver seconded the motion. MCU

**Treasurers Report:** Financial reports of revenues and expenditures were distributed for approval. The General Fund Account stands at \$403,314.83. Liquid Fuels State Account Balance is \$92,308.10. The Board also reviewed April payroll and April paid invoices. Justin Snook motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report/payroll/invoices as presented. Rodney Weaver seconded. MCU

The Board authorized the treasurer to pay all incoming bills for the month of May, 2026.

**Certificate of Deposit:** A Certificate of Deposit from FNB was deposited at Turbotville National Bank at 3.95%, on February 20, 2026. The amount of the deposit was \$204,999.86 with a maturity date of February 20, 2027.

John L Stoltzfus Escrow account balance as of 03/31/26 is \$7,900.40. Interest earned \$1.73 (0.25%)

**Public Comment:** Jeff Corson was present and asked to be updated on Wagmyr Woodlands HOA court case? The Township has no information.

**Report of Planning Commission:** The Planning Commission met on April 15, 2026. The agenda item was Preliminary/Final Subdivision for Jacob & Malinda Beiler and Henry & Sarah Beiler. The plan was tabled due to absence of a representative at the meeting and a plan (revised) to review.

**Report of Zoning Officer:** Zoning Officer Kyle Kehoe emailed the April zoning report. Three zoning permits were issued for April, 2026 in the amount of \$1,055.00.

**Emergency Management Coordinator Report:** Chris was present and reported that all is busy.

### UNFINISHED/OLD BUSINESS

**Line Painting:** We received the fully Executed Agreement for line painting from Ryan Scanlan with PLP Company, LLC. The company will be coordinating with each municipality for scheduling.

**Road Project 2026:** Pending

**File Cabinet purchase:** Pending

**Wide Mirror purchase:** Pending an invoice for purchase to bring to the meeting.

**CCATO Convention:** The CCATO convention is May 7, 2026. Rodney Weaver and Mala Moore plan to attend.

**Dirt & Gravel ESM Certification:** Rodney Weaver will be required to recertify his ESM Certification in order to be eligible for Dirt & Gravel Funding. Classes are being offered in Clearfield and Centre County.

### NEW BUSINESS

**Rezone of East Valley from Ag & Residential:** There was discussion of rezone from agriculture to residential as some citizens are concerned with a zoning permit for a chicken barn at 3544 East Valley Road, Loganton, PA. The Board discussed it with the citizens present and that it may be considered spot zoning. The Board did not discuss it with our counsel; however, there are some loops to achieve rezoning. At the meeting there were discussions and suggestions made to the citizens with their real concerns of the new project. Right-to-farm act was discussed. Also ombudsman is helpful for citizens. They are available to be a go between when conflicts may arise.

**Grant Application:** An application was submitted to Clinton County Commissioners for our 2026 Road Project. It was hand delivered on April 21, 2026 to the commissioner's office.

**Treasurer Bond increase:** Upon filling out a Treasurer's bond application, our insurance company suggested we increase the bond to \$500,000. Justin Snook motioned that the bond be increased to cover \$500,000 (treasurer bond amount quote is \$500.00 per year). Rodney Weaver seconded the motion. MCU

**Crack Seal Proposal:** Two proposals were submitted for review. They were: Russell Standard and Midland Asphalt. One was quoted by gallons and one was quoted by lineal feet. Both quotes were priced at \$24,300.00 (threshold for unadvertised quotes). Justin Snook motioned to accept Midland Asphalt quote of \$24,300.00. Rodney Weaver seconded the motion. MCU

**Sugar Valley Concerned Citizens/Goodwill Ambulance Co:** Sugar Valley Concerned Citizens (SVCC) had their meeting on April 29, 2026. Background: Goodwill Ambulance sent a letter asking for \$4,500.00 per municipality for expenses incurred to serve the townships and boroughs under their care. They are asking for the support of \$4,500.00 for insurance and other expenses to maintain services for the citizens of Greene Township, Logan Township, and Loganton Borough. SVCC (by membership vote) will issue a check for \$5,000.00 each to Greene Township, Logan Township, and Loganton Borough to be directly given to Goodwill Ambulance. This is done with the fire relief check that comes from the state and is directly given to Sugar Valley Volunteer Fire Co. The process for the township is; a check in the amount of \$5,000.00 will be received from SVCC. Greene Township will deposit the check into the General Fund account and then a check in the amount of \$5,000.00 will be written and mailed out to Goodwill Ambulance Service in Flemington, PA.
